



Minutes of May 1, 2007 Meeting

The monthly meeting of the CCMAFC was convened at 5:30 PM on Tuesday, May 1st, at the Seven Points DQ. Fourteen members were present, with four Model A's being driven to the meeting (Walt and Virginia Hellebrand, Bill and Sue Capps, Shorty Johnson and Jim Blakeney). The meeting was called to order by the President, Sue Capps, who led a prayer, and Walt Hellebrand led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Shirley Dyess read the April minutes. Bill Capps made a motion to accept the minutes, Walt seconded, and the motion carried. Shirley also read the April Financial Report.

Sunshine Report: Janelle Seabourne sent a card to Virginia Hellebrand. Shirley and Don Dyess both have May birthdays, and the group sang Happy Birthday.

Old Business

Sue reported on the various April tours for the Club, including Cruise Night at the Dairy Queens and the Edom (short and sweet) and Corsicana Derrick Days (solemn) parades. Joe told us "Bill's Hard Luck Story," which was about Bill Wittner's bad luck with his car on the return trip from Edom. Some of the members also went to Athens and to Kaufman for other parades in April, and Sue mentioned that she met some potential new members who may be joining the Club soon.

Sue mentioned that she is still selling \$5 raffle tickets for the motor to be given away at the June Texas Tour in Tyler. Next month will be our last drawing for the free ticket given to a lucky winner who drove an "A" to our monthly meeting.

New Business

Sue reminded everyone of Emory Founder's Day on May 5th, and the Ennis Polka Festival Parade on May 26th. We will meet for the Ennis trip at the Dairy Queen in Seven Points at 7:00 AM for breakfast, and leave between 8:00 to 8:15 AM for Ennis.

We will also repeat the tour through the countryside between Seven Points and Kerens on May 11th, leaving the Gibson's parking lot at 8:45 AM and lunching at the Grub and Gossip in Kerens after the tour.

Although we will still plan to have some sort of fifth anniversary celebration in November, the Ford dealership in Mabank will participate in an event to commemorate our anniversary on Saturday, June 30th. While the insulation on the points from Piranio's was adequate, the insulation thickness on the expensive points was much better.

Joe advised against using Standard Brand points.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded, and the meeting was adjourned.
