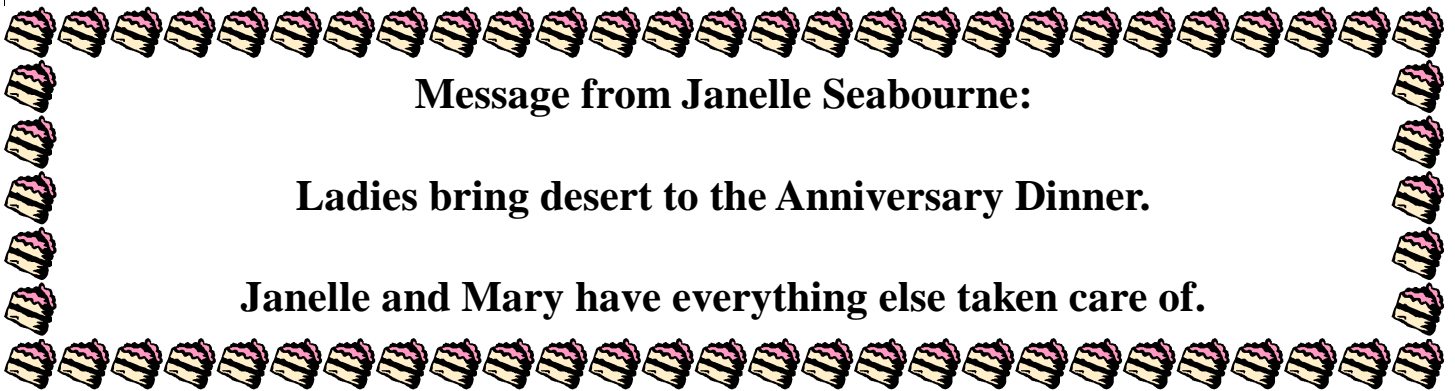
Walt Hellebrand, for Club President
