Joe Creecy made a motion to accept the October minutes as written in the Newsletter, John Bell seconded, and the motion carried. Shirley read the October Financial Report.

<u>Sunshine Report</u>: November birthdays include Mary Worman, Janelle Seabourne, Erma Reynolds and Clark Clay. We sang Happy Birthday to Clark, the only one present at the meeting. Sue reported that Shorty is doing better every day. Jimmy Reynolds has broken his kneecap and will require surgery.

Old Business

Bill Wittner reported on one of the car shows in Athens (3 Model A's) and Paul on the other one (1 Model A, Paul won a trophy). Don volunteered to lead the Brown's Valley and Corsicana Pioneer Village tours next year, even though he will not be the Tour Director, since he had already planned these tours but we were not able to complete them because of the weather. 
