A preliminary design for a 12,000 square foot museum has been proposed, modeled after a 1929 design for a Ford dealer building. Total cost, including exhibits, is estimated to be \$1.6 million. Since only 25% of that amount has been raised, additional donations and fundraising are still needed before any discussions with a design/build contractor can be started.

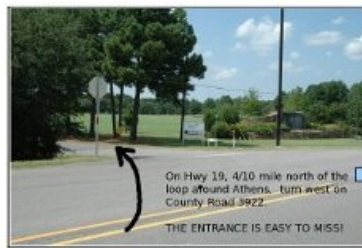
