Roberto's Mom: (From Roberto)

Jan 7: Over the holidays Mom got a little sick with all the stuff going around. She ended up at the ER in Texarkana. Friday they decided to put her on the ventilator and air lifted her to Baylor. She has been in ICU on the transplant floor. Yesterday she finally got off the ventilator and is breathing on her own and can talk. She seems to be getting better everyday. ... This has definitely put her on priority for a transplant, but it is still just waiting for the right match

Jan 15: Mom had her double transplant surgery last night. They finished up around 1. Everything went as well as it could have gone.

Jan 17: I am amazed at her progress. She was helped into a chair yesterday, was able to eat a little, and even did a few minutes of rehab using a little peddle machine. Blood pressure has been staying a little low, and it is still painful to take the big deep breaths that she is not used to. They say she may get out of ICU today or tomorrow.

Jan 25: My Mom got discharged from the hospital yesterday. ... She is doing well and is extremely happy. She is still in pain, but that is to be expected. Amazing to see miracles at work.
