Shirley called Jody to let her know Danny had a stroke in Athens last night & is in intensive care in the hospital there. They won't know for several days how much damage has been done. Jody is waiting for a connecting flight in California & asked me to let everyone know.

Hey Sue – thanks for the call – I was at the hospital this morning – then took care of some things - including the DQ in Seven Points. The Queens appear to be doing just fine. My phone doesn't work very well at the hospital (like not at all) and not very well at the DQ either.

Danny is pretty much the same – in other words no miraculous recovery – which I understand is pretty much normal for these kinds of things. It is all about time. And he has a long haul ahead of him. He is still having times of agitation/anxiety but slept most of the time I was there – not a bad thing I guess. They have found he has AFIB so they are trying to control that with an IV med and also starting some fluids for dehydration. But they have to be careful with the fluids because he can't have get too much cause of fluid buildup. He had a chest x-ray while I was there to make sure there was no pneumonia. They felt the Afib may have caused the strokes if the blood wasn't being pumped totally out of his heart and tiny clots formed which went to his brain. That's about all I know.
