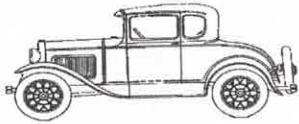

Have you ever thought about license plates and their history? License plates have been around for almost 100 years. In 1907 a Texas House Bill #93 required that all motor vehicles used on public roads be registered with the county clerk. Vehicles received a number in the order registered in each county. That number had to be at least six inches in height and was required to be displayed "in a conspicuous place" on the vehicle. In addition to acquiring antique plates for our restored cars, collecting antique automobile plates have become quite a hobby and the hunt for those special antique license plates can be quite rewarding.
