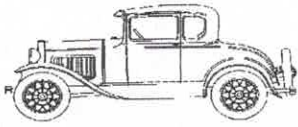

Ford Facts

Ford Airplanes During the days that the Ford Motor Company was manufacturing Model A's , the company had another plant that made airplanes. These planes were all metal and had three engines with propellers Most planes of the day were partly made of wood. For that time it was the most advanced design and construction, capable of taking a load of twelve passengers, or a ton of freight into the air. The company operated an air service for transportation of passengers, mail and freight between manufacturing plants in different cities. The flying activities centered at the Ford Airport in Dearborn, Michigan, which was one of the finest aviation fields in the country.
