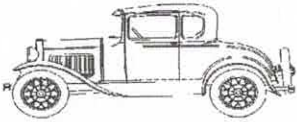

This month's tech tip. REMOVING A STUCK HEAD

If you are trying to remove your Model A head and it is stuck, remove all head stud nuts. Take out all spark plugs and using your hand crank turn the engine over until pistons #2 and #3 are at top dead center. A light will aid in looking into the #2 and #3 spark plug holes. Use two pieces of 3/8" cotton or nylon rope, several feet long and of equal length. Feed one end of each rope into the #1 and #4 cylinders through the spark plug holes. Now use the hand crank to turn the engine, compressing the rope. With a little force on the crank, the head will lift up.
