Tour and Outing Information

Hi Folks,

I believe that we made the right decision to postpone our January tour. It would have been unbearably cold in that metal building for the Telephone Museum Tour.

As for rescheduling this tour, we are looking at Friday, March 9th, or Monday, March 12th as the dates for the tour of the Telephone Museum and Watkins Wildlife Museum. I will provide the final date as soon as I receive confirmation from the museums, but no later than our March 6th meeting.

For February I am looking at a country drive that will put us in Kerens for lunch at the D&D Restaurant around 11:30 AM. The food may not be as good, but this will be a drive similar to the one we took to The Shed in Edom, just in a different direction and, hopefully, new roads. We should meet at the old Gibson's parking lot across from the Seven Points Dairy Queen at 8:45 AM. We will leave there at 9:00 AM and drive down Highway 85 through Chatfield to Highway 636. Turning left onto Highway 636 we will go through Brown's Valley and, weather and roads permitting, we will leave the paved roads a few miles north of Bazette. This will take us through the old Crowley and Trammel bottoms, past the old Wilson School, Prairie Point, and just before we reach Bazette we will take another "Model A" road which will bring us back to Highway 636 just north of Kerens. After lunch we have the choice of returning to Seven Points through the "back country" or by Highway 31, your choice. Let's set a tentative date of February 16th for this tour bearing in mind that February weather is highly unpredictable and we can change the date with a moments notice.

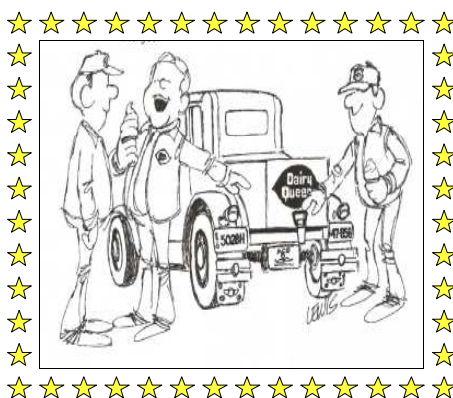

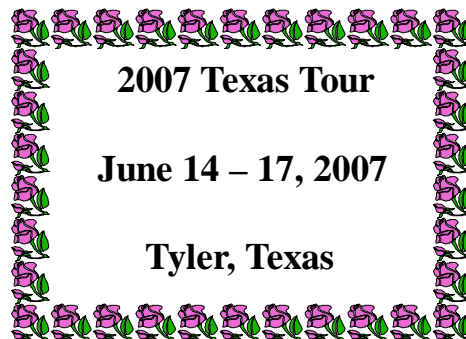
